Dear Parent/Guardian,

Re: Geography Fieldtrip to the Bay of Naples, Italy, 13th – 16th of July 2020

I am delighted to inform you that we have had an incredible amount of interest in the trip to the Bay of Naples, Italy, to make it a viable trip. Thank you for your deposit of £150 to secure your child's place on the fieldtrip. Please note that this means your deposit is now non-refundable as it has been paid to secure our flights for the trip.

The final cost of the trip will be **£615**. We are pleased that we have been able to keep the cost of the trip in line with previous years especially in the current political climate, along with the loss of Thomas Cook airlines, which have driven up flight costs.

The price includes:

- Return flights between London and Nápoli, Capodichino International Airport (please note departing from Luton and returning to Gatwick).
- 3 nights accommodation on a half board basis at the 3* Hotel Cosmomare <u>https://www.cosmomare.it/en</u> located on the Sorrento Coast. The hotel has access to a beach, which may be enjoyed under supervision from teaching staff.
- Airport transfers in the UK and Italy.
- Travel insurance.
- The itinerary will include:
 - o A guided tour of the World Heritage Site of Pompeii.
 - Climbing Mount Vesuvius with a fully trained volcanologist walking around the rim of the volcanic crater (note the coach takes you three-quarters of the way up and you walk the rest!).
 - A guided tour of the World Heritage Site of Herculaneum, which was preserved by volcanic ejecta from the same eruption as Pompeii.
 - Ferry crossing for a full day trip to the island of Capri and Anacapri.
 - A school guided tour of Sorrento, life in the shadow of Mount Vesuvius.

Three members of staff will accompany students on the trip. A further letter will follow in the Spring term with the final itinerary, as well as a suggested kit list. Attached to this letter is a request of dietary and medical information that we need to be aware of for the trip. We will request full emergency contact details and any other medical requirements in 2020. If you have any queries or concerns before then please do not hesitate to email: <u>BrownAm@tuptonhall.org.uk</u>.

Please remember that, students are ambassadors of Tupton Hall School when on school trips. Therefore, it is imperative that student behaviour is <u>exemplary</u>.
