

WHAT IS CREST?

Bronze Awards, suitable for ages 11 upwards. It introduces students to project work empowering them to work like real scientists, technologists, engineers or mathematicians. Students choose their own topic and methodologies giving them complete freedom over their work.

Students work independently or in groups to plan and run a project addressing a real-world STEM problem. The project process develops enquiry, problem-solving and communication skills.. Bronze project are assessed against the CREST assessment criteria. After completing the project, each student receives a personalised certificate.


