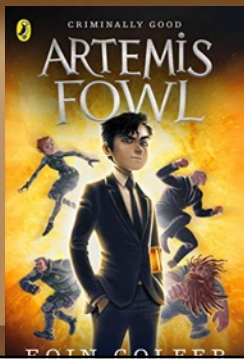


**The Frozen Sea by Piers Torday**
