- 1. Rooftoppers is set in Paris. Research Paris landmarks and then create your own map where you plot each of the famous sites.
- 2. Rooftoppers is set in the Victorian/Edwardian era. Research the lives of children, women and the existence of orphanages; historical transport and clothes during this time.
- 3. "A baby was washed up in a Cello case..." complete the first chapter of the novel. You can use your imagination and take the story in any direction you choose.

  This music is played in the book. From listening to it can you answer the following auestions.

- 6. Using the picture below of Victorian orphans. Create a character who could appear in the book. You need to give your character a name, back story (what has happened in their life up to now) describe the type of person they are and illustrate them.
